1. A brief written recommendation from the current Arts Teacher or Private Instructor listed above.
2. Instrumental, Vocal, or Theater Students: an audition CD. (Note: If student received a rating at a District Solo & Ensemble Festival, you may send a copy of the rating sheet instead of a CD). Guitar, Soprano Sax not eligible for Merit Scholarships.
Instrumental - include a solo or etude (with or without accompaniment) and three major scales demonstrating your instrument's range.
Vocal - include warm-ups consisting of scales and arpeggios demonstrating vocal range, and a prepared solo (accompanied or unaccompanied).
Theater - include a one to two minute monologue of your choice; and a musical excerpt if auditioning for Musical Theater.
3. Art students: submit photos of 2-3 original works (do not send original artwork). Label with your first and last name, and your current grade.
